Covid Vaccination Update:

The Ministry announced a deadline for 3rd doses for all eligible staff, student placements, volunteers, support workers and caregivers and to provide proof of having received a third dose by March 14 2022 , unless they have a valid medical exemption. In addition, those who are only eligible to receive a third dose after March 14 must provide proof of a third dose within 30 days of becoming eligible. We strongly encourage everyone to receive their third dose as soon as possible after becoming eligible.
